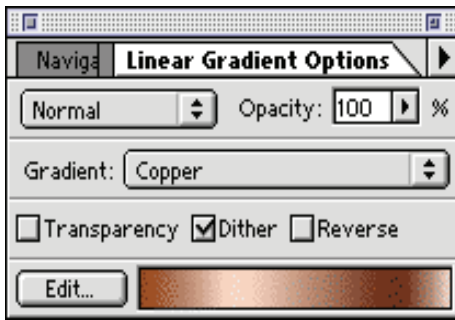
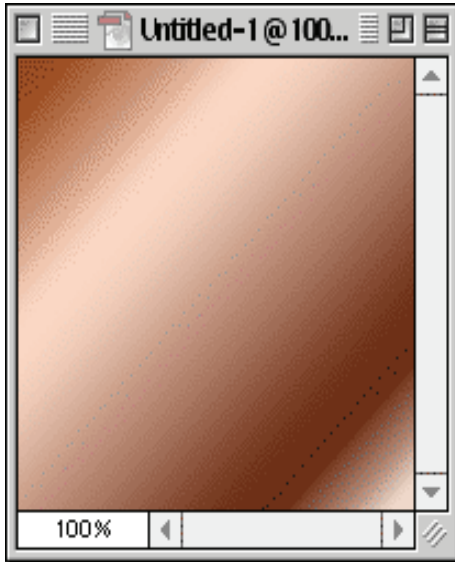


Brushed Metal



Step one:

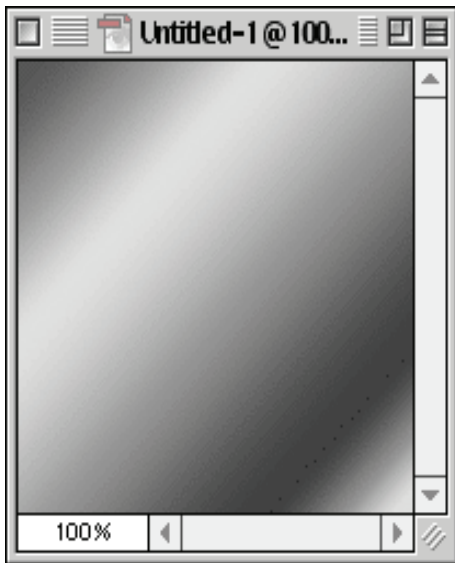
Open a new document (RGB mode). Double-click on the Gradient tool and in the Gradient Tool options palette, choose Copper as your gradient.



Using the Gradient tool, drag a gradient from the upper left hand corner down to the bottom right hand corner of your image.

Go under the Image menu, under Adjust, and choose Desaturate to remove the copper color.

Go under the Filter menu, under Noise, and choose Add Noise. Enter 20 - 30 for amount, and choose the Gaussian and Monochromatic options, then click OK.



Go under the Filter menu, under Blur and choose Motion Blur. When the dialog box appears, choose 20 - 30 for amount, and set your angle to 29 degrees, then click OK to complete the texture.
